Fair Funding for Rural Schools in Devon

For years I have been involved in the Campaign for Fair Funding for our rural schools. In 2016/17 School Funding from the DofE was £290 per child less than average for England.

The Leader of Devon County Council John Hart has made numerous trips to Westminster lobbying for a fairer system, last year securing an increase of £190 per child as a one off.

Sadly, new proposals represent a step backwards. Whilst In 2017/18 funding per pupil will increase slightly Devon Schools would still be £268 below the England average, representing a 24 million shortfall, compounded by schools facing substantially increased costs in coming years, increased NHIC and Apprenticeship Levy contributions.

These proposals for the National Funding Formula would result in 129 (37%) Devon schools and 6/10 children losing funds, with 212 (62%) Devon school gaining, and 2(1%) no change.

Most of the schools in Cullompton Rural, including Cullompton Community College, St Andrews Primary, Willowbank, The Duchy School, as well as Uffculme High School will lose out substantially if these proposals are implemented. I am <u>very</u> disappointed, and believe this is a serious mistake, which must be challenged. No Devon school should lose funding!

It has been reported that Devon County Council have reduced their schools budget. The real problem is Devon does not receive enough funding from the DofE for education.

In reality DCC have <u>not</u> reduced their overall schools budget but in addition to the National Funding Formula, Devon does not have sufficient funds, due to a large increase the number of children with High Needs coming through. Therefore it has been necessary to re-allocate £33 from main stream budget to honour a Statutory obligation to fund the most vulnerable.

I am very unhappy with this, but it has been necessary in order to balance the Devon Education budget. Despite historic low funding Devon's schools have done a fantastic job in achieving high outcomes and good results. Imagine what could be achieved with adequate funding?

I have great sympathy with the schools and pupils who will be affected and it would be really appreciated if as many people as possible would join me in responding to this Consultation.




Come and sing in the Festival with Bradninch Festival Choir!

Helen comes back to Bradninch

Many of you will know Helen Kearney, who was a leader of the Bradninch Cubs and a first responder in Bradninch for the S West Ambulance Service, before she moved to Elder Farm, a five and a half acre organic farm near Wellington which is part of the



Ecological Land Co-operative's first site in the UK.

Helen is a medical herbalist and uses her plot to grow herbs to make into medicines, soap and other herbal products, and edible and cut flowers.

Helen is giving a talk on medicinal herbs at the Guildhall on March 15th at 7.30pm, hosted by Bradninch Gardening Club. Everyone is welcome, the cost for non members is just £1.

Elder Farm is a small off grid medicinal herb farm, which is being established using permaculture principles. They offer a range of learning opportunities for visitors from the UK and abroad. Their goal is to reconnect people to sustainable growing methods, and to the amazing healing power of plants.

Supporting Devon's Rural Entrepreneurs

Devon Communities Together (DCT) has been awarded £50,000 from The Prince's Countryside Fund to support the next generation of rural entrepreneurs in Devon. A series of free networking events and one-to-one advice and mentoring activities will be provided to support start-ups with key business skills such as finance and marketing. As part of the project, DCT is developing an online enterprise hub to support this learning.

They are also working with the School for Social Entrepreneurs in Dartington, who will deliver a programme of in-depth training to further support and encourage business development and long-term growth.

Project manager Mike Felstead, commented: "Devon follows the UK trend for small business size, with over 70% of companies in the county employing less than four people. Start-ups typically fall into this size category, so it's vitally important they are supported and nurtured. The project is running until July 2018, so this is a terrific opportunity for rural entrepreneurs to get free, hands-on support.for a good time span. This should certainly help them to get through the difficult first stages of launch and initial growth."



Complementary therapy was frowned upon when I was at medical school. In the mid 1980's the medical press denounced acupuncture on a regular basis. However now it is a fully recognized part of hospital pain management programmes and has a scientific database that is supportive of its use. It is now relatively common for GPs to use treatments such as acupuncture, hypnosis, and a variety of relaxation techniques including Mindfulness (adapted from Buddhist philosophy).

Complementary therapies are not all scientifically proven to be as effective as their enthusiasts would wish however they almost all have one thing in common: they enable a therapist to spend individual time with a patient over a period of weeks or months. It is interesting that the ground rules of continuity and consistency seen in complementary therapies are also the core feature of good General Practice.

Although GPs are unable to have the luxury of a one hour initial assessment we do have the flexibility of seeing patients more often when required and several 10 minute slots over many weeks soon add up. Often the frequency makes up for the limited length as the effects of time on symptoms is one of the strongest pieces of information regarding diagnosis that we have.

There have been many breakthroughs in medicine over the last 30 years but maybe none as fundamentally important as the realization that the time spent with the practitioner is probably the most important part of most therapy. The doctor as the drug has been a theory that has been difficult to prove. Science requires strict control conditions that cannot be easily created in consultations.

Patients are not blind to who we see and as in all relationships we will have preferences. The fact that this relationship itself contributes to patients getting better is referenced this month in a study in the British Medical Journal showing that patients who see the same GP are less likely to require hospital admission when sick. The benefits of continuity of care and the trust that develops over time are essential to good medicine and it is great that the research to prove this is starting to be published.

Caring for your pet's teeth

Like humans, cats and dogs have a set of baby teeth that fall out and then have a set of adult teeth that need to last for the rest of their life!

Caring for these teeth will help ensure your pet doesn't suffer from any of the problems associated with poor dental hygiene:

- Plague and tartar
- Swollen/painful gums, sometimes receding from the teeth leaving them loose or falling out.
- Bad breath, caused by bacteria (not nice for them or us!). In severe cases the bacteria can enter the blood stream, potentially damaging internal organs.

What can you do to help prevent dental disease?



We brush our teeth every day, so why not brush your pet's teeth too?!

There are many different pet toothbrushes and toothpastes available. Don't use your own toothpaste as this is not safe for pets. It is best to start brushing your pet's teeth from a young age so they learn to accept it; however, it is possible to start slowly and gently with an older pet too.



Feeding a biscuit diet that your pet has to crunch on can help to keep the teeth clean. There are many specially formulated dental

diets that contain everything your pet needs. Dental chews can also be used to keep the teeth clean. Remember, these contain additional calories so reduce daily ration to allow for this.



Anti plaque water additives

It is possible to add a special solution to your pet's drinking water. This contains an-

tibacterial agents and an ingredient that helps stop plague and tartar formation. This can be purchased from your Veterinary Surgery.

Dental treatment

Sometimes it may be necessary for teeth to be cleaned at the vets. In order to examine

the teeth and scale them, it is usually necessary for them to have a general anaesthetic. Some teeth may need to be removed during the procedure. This can be a lengthy and costly process and is not often covered by pet insurance.

So prevention is definitely better than the cure! A Veterinary Nurse can check your pet's teeth (normally a free service), and will be able to advise you on the best dental care for your pet.
