Make Your Metals Matter

Mid Devon District Council has teamed up with the metal packaging manufacturing industry and Recycle Devon to launch the 'Make Your Metals Matter' campaign to all its residents.

We use over forty four million cans, foil trays and aerosols every year in Mid Devon, the metal they are made from is endlessly recyclable and the council is determined to make sure every last one makes it into your recycling container so that they can be transformed into something new.

To encourage metal recycling, Recycle Devon is giving five lucky Mid Devon residents who pledge to recycle the metal within their home a family ticket to one of Devon's Top Attractions in 2021. To pledge simply visit recycledevon.org/metal-matters by Sunday 6, December for your chance to win.

The 'Make Your Metals Matter' campaign will include leaflets sent to 37,109 homes and will be supported with social media with the aim of reminding residents to recycle all the metal packaging found around their home, including:

- Food and drink cans
- Foil trays
- Empty aerosols
- Metal screw tops from glass bottles and jars
- Household aluminium wrapping foil used for baking or wrapping leftovers

If all of the metal packaging used in Mid Devon's homes each year was collected for recycling it would save around 1191 tonnes of carbon dioxide, the equivalent to taking 253 cars off local streets for a year.

Used metal packaging can be recycled into new products at a far lower cost to the environment than making them from raw materials. Making drinks cans from recycled material saves up to 95% of the energy and greenhouse gas emissions needed to make both aluminium and steel from raw materials. What's more, every time metal passes through the recycling loop the benefits are repeated, again and again and again!

Christmas is definitely not cancelled according to local tree nursery Pixton Woodlands at Bampton who are offering a free home delivery service of traditional Nordmann Fir Christmas Trees across Devon and Somerset. Ordering is simple and easy through their website (www.pixtonchristmas.co.uk). Walk-in customers are very welcome to visit the nursery and select their own tree, with a little help from the friendly staff.

In recognition of the bravery and hard work of the NHS during 2020, Pixton is making a generous donation of proceeds to the Devon and Somerset NHS Partnership Trusts and offering NHS staff a discount through the Health Staff Discount Scheme.

The delivery service is an ideal way to help those who are shielding or keeping to the rules to help stop the spread of Covid 19.

SILVERTON & EXE VALLEY SENIORS AUTUMN NEWSLETTER

Earlier in the year it had been hoped that the coronavirus restrictions might have achieved their desired effect by the end of the summer, holding out the possibility of being able to offer some activities in the last quarter of the year. However, National Trust properties (including Lanhydrock) remain closed as is the Brecon Mountain Railway (both outings being due to take place in October) and the Club has been notified by the organisers of the Gloucester Christmas Market (November) that they reluctantly, had to cancel the event this year. That left only the last outing in the programme (Christmas Lunch at the Waie Inn) to be considered.

Even had venues remained open, the planned outings may not have been able to take place as with 2M distancing permitting a maximum of about 26 passengers, financial viability whittling away our reserves in the order of £200 per outing would have been an issue without a price increase. As for St Mary's Church Hall, we have been advised that the maximum number of people permitted to enter the building under covid-19 regulations is only six which is not much good for Coffee Mornings. Playing whist would have been similarly affected but of course social distancing and the handling of cards would have been contrary to everything which the coronavirus restrictions were designed to prevent.

Looking now at the planned Christmas Lunch outing on Friday 18th December, Blakes are operating coaches again and the Waie inn has two coronavirus compliant sized rooms each able to accommodate 30 diners but which might mean splitting the group subject to demand. Against the background of warnings of a second surge in the disease this winter and bearing in mind our age group with some people shielding, it seems perhaps over optimistic to hope that the level of risk will have been sufficiently lowered to enable this event and other Club events to take place safely. The decision that has been taken to cancel the outing will, I know, be a big disappointment to many members and their friends particularly those who live alone and are desperate to get out and to renew old friendships but in the prevailing circumstances the Committee and I believe that there is no realistic alternative.

As we have been unable to enjoy any of the varied of outings arranged for 2020 the plan is to rearrange most of these outings for next year and to hope that these will be able to take place. My initial thoughts, subject to better times ahead (in tune with the Prime Minister's statement on the 22nd SEP) are that the outings programme would not start until April or May (instead of March) whilst the other activities such as coffee mornings and whist would recommence when circumstances permit. Details of the rearranged programme will be advised in December/January and as previously advised 2020 subscriptions will be carried forward to next year when I hope that the Club will again be able to offer existing and prospective new members an interesting and varied programme of activities for 2021..

Hands, Space, Face and Connect

As I write the mornings are dark and the evenings are drawing in. However the last few days have been crisp and the leaves on the trees are a golden red and yellow that make my drive to work a mix of impressive shade and colour. It is a time of change, a time to reflect, and a time to plan for the winter. All of this of course mirrors where we currently are and I am afraid predicting where we are going would be foolhardy.

Over this winter connecting with as many people as possible, using whatever routes available, will be essential; a quick 'Hello' over the garden fence is just as important as a long Zoom call with a relative in Australia. Making sure we all have as many avenues of communication as possible is really important. The internet and computers are fully integrated into the lives of the majority of the population; everyone in my family gets withdrawal symptoms very quickly if the WiFi is out of action. However, there is a large percentage of those over 65 who do not use computers, smart phones and iPads as much as they could. With these in mind the surgery launched our Digital Social Prescribing Scheme at the beginning of this year led by Joan Povey. The roll out was hampered by the lockdown however this has also led to many more people equipping themselves with new or updated electronic equipment over the summer. Joan is on hand to help you learn to get started or enhance your internet skills so you can do on-line shopping, order prescriptions, make video calls with family and friends and research all sorts of information. She is able to help anyone who lives in the local community even if they are not registered at Wyndham House Surgery. Her email is wyndhamsp@gmail.com or you can phone to leave your contact details at the reception in Wyndham House Surgery and she will give you a ring. No matter how much or little you know, if you want to learn more please contact Joan - she is a wealth of information, a fantastic teacher and will find a way of helping you out.

It is entirely possible that a vaccination for Covid will start to be rolled out before Christmas however it is also far more certain that whatever the science produces we will be restricted in our socialising and normal activities until at least Spring and more probably the summer. So, as winter comes, it is really important to stay distant, wash your hands as frequently as possible, wear masks and ensure you have made the connections with your family, your neighbours and your community as strong as possible.
